Student Awards Criteria



The following is the list of awards which will be presented at each Awards Ceremony.

Pre-K & Kindergarten

Most Improved - is awarded to two students who have made the most improvement during the marking period regardless of their academic grade point average.

Most Effort - is awarded to two students who have displayed the most effort during the marking period regardless of their academic grade point average.

Perfect Attendance - is awarded to those students with 100% attendance and **no more than 2 tardies and 2 excused early**.

Student of the Month - is awarded to a student each month selected by the teacher to have exemplified good character traits throughout the month.

Grades 1-5

Principal's Honor Roll – is awarded to those students who display good citizenship and have earned a grade point average of 4.0 in academic areas as well as A's in conduct and 1's in effort.

Honor Roll – is awarded to those students who have all A's and B's in academic areas as well as A's and B's in conduct and 1's and 2's in effort.

Citizenship (Conduct) – is awarded to those students who display good citizenship in all areas (classroom, special area classes, cafeteria, etc.) regardless of their academic grade point average and have earned conduct grades of A's in all subject areas.

Most Improved – is awarded to two students who have made the most improvement during the marking period regardless of their academic grade point average.

Most Effort – is awarded to two students who have displayed the most effort during the marking period regardless of their academic grade point average.

Perfect Attendance – is awarded to those students with 100% attendance and **no more than 2 tardies and 2 excused early**.

Student of the Month – is awarded to a student each month selected by the teacher to have exemplified good character traits throughout the month.
